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This “String Band Record” is divided into three separate parts. The first is entitled “**Facts and Fallacies**”, which document the rumors that are present in the String Band Division. They mostly deal with the bands themselves. The second is entitled “**Band Information**”, which deals mostly with dates that certain bands were founded on, or which bands have actually made it up the street since their founding without ever missing a parade. The last section is the “**String Band Record**” itself, giving the most comprehensive index of every String Band that ever marched, the actual theme title (where known), and their prize money that was awarded. Please rest assured that this String Band Record was built from scratch using only original newspaper sources dating from 1902-on. Since many existing String Band compilation lists have incorrect information, or omissions, they were not used.

Compiling this list has been a labor of love, and a quest for knowledge. In the actual process, I have tried to do a number of things. First of all, to find out the truths to various “mummers rumors”. There are a lot, and I have found out correct information on the most incorrect ones.

Secondly were the theme titles. Not the shortened versions that the newspapers used to take up less space, but the actual submitted titles with every if, and, or but included. I have tried to collect them all, but am still missing some actual titles. The ones that I am either sure of, or 95% sure of, I included quotes with. “Our Theme Title”- for example.

Some of the earliest bands had no actual titles. They were Jockeys, or Pirates, and just called themselves accordingly. These would, of course, be without quotes as well.

The official prize money was not hard to come by, even in the earliest bands. One must remember, also, that the String Band division did not start until the 1916 parade. This means that, before that year, the bands were viewed as musical groups in the eyes of the judges, and were allowed to win the same prizes that the comic and fancy groups (the only two divisions marching before 1916) could win. These prizes were most always a “numbered” prize, (5th prize...2nd prize...etc.) and came under a category (“most comical club”...”brigade”...”special features and floats”).

One thing that I am certain of is that every band listed here marched, and that I have not left any band out. It is also interesting to see the theme title mistakes made over the years, and brought along from String Band Theme list to list. The last place band of 1923; Charles Reach (which was a Progressive Club in Philadelphia at that time) was mistakenly listed as “Beach Progressive Club String Band” in various sources. Such mistakes are common in all of the existing String Band prize lists.

## **FACTS AND FALLACIES**

### **THERE WERE TWO TRILBY STRING BANDS THROUGHOUT HISTORY. - TRUE.**

Most modern-day String Band fans fail to realize that there were two “Trilbys”. The Original Trilby String Band (organized in 1935 and last marched 2016) sometimes is confused with the Trilby String Band (organized 1898 and last marched in 1924). These are two separate organizations: The Trilby String Band marched on and off from 1902 until 1920. One of the original founders of the Trilby String Band, a gentleman named Louis Samuels, owned the Trilby charter, and after a number of dismal prizes, broke up the band in 1920. In 1923, former band members Dave Nelson and John Wygand asked Louis to bring the band out once again for the 1924 parade, to which Louis reluctantly agreed. The end result for Trilby in the 1924 parade was a last-place honorable mention (along with the Franklin String Band), a fifty-dollar prize, and a vow from Louis Samuels that the Trilby String Band was cursed, and would never march again. The Trilby String Band disbanded for good after the 1924 parade.

Eleven years later, in 1935, three musicians, Dave Nelson, Johnny Dryer and George Boettger wanted to organize their own string band. They were thinking up names for their new band, and Dave Nelson suggested calling it “Trilby”, after the band that he marched in over a decade ago. They decided to do just that, even going as far as having badges made up with “Trilby String Band 1936” stamped on them. What they didn’t realize was that Louis Samuels, one of the founders of Trilby was still around, and still owned the Trilby String Band charter. Samuels threatened the new bandsmen with a lawsuit if they didn’t call their new band something else.

Not knowing what to do now, with already having their “Butterflys” theme ready to go for the 1936 Mummies’ Parade, and last-minute touches finished, they decided to name their new string band the “Original Trilby String Band”. With that, they registered their new band under that name in Harrisburg, and had a rubber stamp made up with the word “ORIGINAL”. They then proceeded to change all of their new “Trilby String Band-1936 parade badges into “ORIGINAL Trilby String Band-1936” parade badges. (One of which exists to this day in the Mummies’ Museum). Louis Samuels was now quiet about the new band, and the brand new Original Trilby String Band marched for the first time on January 1, 1936, and finished sixth with a butterfly theme. This is the more current band that had marched on and off up until the 2016 parade. The Original Trilby String Band became defunct in 2017, with most of it’s remaining members joining the Duffy String Band.

### **HEGEMAN INTRODUCED SAXOPHONES TO STRING BANDS.--False.**

Ernest Hegeman, the founder of the Hegeman String Band, is rumored to have had saxophones in his band first. It is known that Hegeman was organized in 1920. However, photographs at the Mummies’ Museum of the 1914 Mummies’ Parade show that the Trilby String Band (1898-1924) had saxophones in the line of march for their “Scottish Minstrels” theme. So, the first instance of saxophones used in String Bands was in the Trilby String Band.

**TRILBY MARCHED IN THE 1901 PHILADELPHIA MUMMERS' PARADE.--False.**

Although a permit to parade was issued to the Trilby String Band (1898-1924) to march in the first city-sponsored Mummers' Parade, there is absolutely no post-parade coverage that mentions the band, and the parade was covered by many different newspapers, each describing the parade in minute detail. It was not uncommon for a band to get a parade permit, or announce that they would march, and then not show up. As an example, the Trixie String Band was listed as a participant in the Eastwick Mummers' Parade in 1934, (along with Woodland) but because of bad weather, only Woodland marched. What is generally believed is that a small number of musicians from Trilby went up under a different name, or as a musical group for a Fancy or Comic club. We do have on record that they did march in the 1902 parade, however, and we also have a photograph of the band for that year.

**THERE WERE NO MUMMERS PARADES IN 1919 AND 1934.--False.**

No, really! It is true that there were no CITY-SPONSORED Mummers Parades in both 1919 and 1934, but there WERE Mummers Parades those years. Modern-day Mummers Parade fans fail to realize that, in the Parade's early years, there were many neighborhood Mummers Parades, all on New Years Day. The city of Camden, New Jersey also held their own Mummers Parade, complete with prize money for the winning organizations, for many years. Different neighborhoods around Philadelphia also held their own parades with prize money up for grabs. A long-held parade was on 2nd Street, with the local businesses banding together to offer groups parading prize money. After many years, the neighborhood parades gave way to the much larger, city-sponsored parade on Broad Street, but, at the time, there WERE Mummers Parades other than Broad Street, and Mummers did parade in these parades in both 1919 and 1934!

**AQUA HAS NEVER MISSED A PARADE SINCE THEIR FIRST PARADE.--False.**

Aqua String Band missed the 1927, 1928 and 1929 parades

## **THE CURRENT QUAKER CITY STRING BAND WON FIRST PRIZES IN 1921 & 1922.— False.**

Newer members of the Quaker City String Band have seen that there was an earlier band with the same name, and, even though the current band has, in the past, advertised their “year established” as 1931 on their clubhouse, parade banner and band apparel, they now wish to also include the two first prizes from this earlier band with the same name, into their win totals.

In doing research, we take into account not only the current band’s advertised year of establishment (as printed above), but also original documentation written by the current band in its formative years, the 1940’s and 1950’s.

Research was completed using original copies of the “Mummers Magazine,” which was an annual publication printed and handed out along the parade route to the many throngs of spectators. Each group performing in the parade would have a photo (from the previous year’s parade, of course), and a write-up, or “brag” sheet, written by the group themselves. Anything positive that one could say about a group went into the few paragraphs on these pages.

It is then very interesting, that in the current band’s early years, no mention whatsoever was made of any first prizes being awarded in 1921 or 1922. In fact, after the first Quaker City String Band was defunct after the 1924 parade, there was no band with that name again until the 1932 parade. The articles do make reference to the earlier band, but by only stating that the newer band was an “offshoot” of an earlier band, or that a few members in the “New Quaker City” marched in the earlier band with the same name decades prior. There is no mention of a charter being renewed, and more interestingly is the fact that the first FIRST PRIZE the current Quaker City listed as having won, was from the 1935 parade, their fourth year marching.

We have reviewed copies of the following years of the “Mummers Magazine”:  
1942, 1944, 1945, 1946, 1947, 1948, 1949 & 1956

Here’s specifically what the research found by year:

1942’s Magazine mentions “The band marching today was reorganized in October, 1930”, and the “winning of a first prize in 1935... and another in 1940”

1944’s Magazine writeup doesn’t mention past prizes

1945’s Magazine writeup, like 1944’s, doesn’t mention past prizes

1946’s Magazine writeup mentions “organized 1920, reorganized 1930, won first prize in 1935, 1940, 1944 & 1945”

1947's Magazine writeup mentions "organized in 1921, disbanded 1925. The band won first prize 1935, 1940, 1944, 1945 and narrowly missed making it three years in a row when they finished second and were barely beaten out by the James Durning Band in 1946..."

1948's Magazine writeup mentions "The Quaker City String Band of today is the outgrowth of the original band that was organized in 1921... (First) Prize winners in 1935, 1940, 1944, 1945 and second in 1946 and 1947..."

1949's Magazine writeup mentions "The Quaker City String Band was organized in the year 1921 under the direction of Mr. Charles Richner... the new Quaker City String Band was activated with many members of the old, original Quaker City in line." "The band won first prize in 1935, 1940, 1944, 1945 and narrowly missed making it three years in a row when they finished second and were barely beaten out by the James Durning Band in 1946..."

1956's Magazine was a special one. The writeup for this year stated: "The Quaker City String Band is celebrating its Twenty-Fifth Anniversary in 1956, and with this in mind they have put forth their best efforts to present a spectacle that will thrill the public. In 1955 Quaker City was a prize winner with its fabulous "Show Business" theme, and their rooters will be even more delighted with the theme for 1956, which is entitled "White Cloud".

So, to conclude,

- 1) The founders of the current Quaker City did not recognize the two wins from 1921 & 1922 as being legitimate wins for their current band's win totals.
- 2) More recently, the current Quaker City celebrated their 25th Anniversary in 1956 (1956 edition of the Mummies Magazine), celebrated their 50th Anniversary in 1981 (1981 theme- "Making Music - 1931: 50th Anniversary", mentioning the band's 50th anniversary on the televised Mummies Parade performance), and celebrated their 75th Anniversary in 2006 with a lavish gala.
- 3) The band advertised, on the front of their clubhouse, on their parade banner and on band apparel, that they were "established in 1931."

Based on the above evidence, the String Band Record will adhere to the current band's historical wishes, and not add the earlier two prizes from the earlier band with the same name, to the current Quaker City's win total.

## **HEGEMAN AND GREATER OVERBROOK BOTH USED THE SAME NAME.-- True.**

Both Hegeman and Greater Overbrook are listed as having used “69th St. String Band” during their respective band histories. In 1932, while all the clubs were preparing for the 1933 Mummers’ Parade, the City of Philadelphia withdrew all funds for the parade because of the toll the Great Depression was taking on the City. To compensate, several mummers clubs staged a “Mummers’ Spectacular” on January 1, 1933 in the old Municipal Stadium. The members of Hegeman were divided: some wanted to march “up the street” with no money or judging, and others wanted to be judged, and perform in the Municipal Stadium performance. The dissension within Hegeman grew, and since Hegeman had actually changed their name to “69th Street String Band” for the 1931 and 1932 parades, the members came up with a radical decision: to split up the Hegeman String Band. The original Hegeman (now being called the 69th St. String Band), would take back the “Hegeman” name for the upcoming 1933 parade, and march up Broad Street, with no judging or prize money. Those members that left because they wanted to perform with judging in the Municipal Stadium extravaganza would form a new String Band, called “69th Street String Band”.

This new band marched for eight years under the 69th Street String Band name, changing to Whitman String Band for the 1939 parade, and then finally, for the 1953 parade, to the modern-day Greater Overbrook String Band.

## **HEGEMAN INTRODUCED THE GLOCKENSPIEL TO STRING BANDS.-False.**

### **AQUA INTRODUCED THE GLOCKENSPIEL TO STRING BANDS.--False.**

This one is probably the most confusing for people that aren’t musicians to comprehend, and this rumor was brought about by confusion of two different instrument types. The two types are both “bell” instruments, but are very different in character to one another. One is called a “**BELL LYRE**”, and the other a “**GLOCKENSPIEL**”.

The difference is that a **bell lyre** is a set of bars set on a lyre in a straight formation (one on top of another) that have a range of a low “C” or “A”, to a high “C”, and have no accidentals. It is modeled after the tuning lyres that orchestras would use to tune. Those tuning lyres would only have a few notes available, including concert “A” for string instruments. There was no need for accidentals. On a bell lyre, they just filled in the remaining notes to make a “C” scale. This would leave for some pretty interesting sounds in a String Band with the bell lyre constantly being off-pitch whenever an accidental should have been played.

A **glockenspiel**, on the other hand, has TWO rows of bars set up on the lyre like a keyboard positioned on its side. All the accidentals are present. There wouldn’t be any “fudging” of notes with a glockenspiel, since every note is available.

The glockenspiel is the instrument that is used in String Bands today.

In all of the earliest pictures of Aqua and Hegeman, a bell lyre is evident, however, photos show us that Trilby used a bell lyre in 1914, 1915, 1917 and 1920, so the first use of a bell lyre in a String Band was with Trilby.

The earliest photo of a band using a glockenspiel is of the Joseph A. Ferko String Band in 1926 for their “Sesqui-Centennial Serenaders” theme.

## **BAND INFORMATION**

Out of the 16 bands that marched in the 2020 parade, 9 have never missed a parade since they first started marching. They are:

Detail was a huge part of the news back then, since there was no TV, so I not only had access to what bands marched, and what ones didn’t, (as well as the theme titles starting in the later years) I would also read of the colors of the suits they wore!
